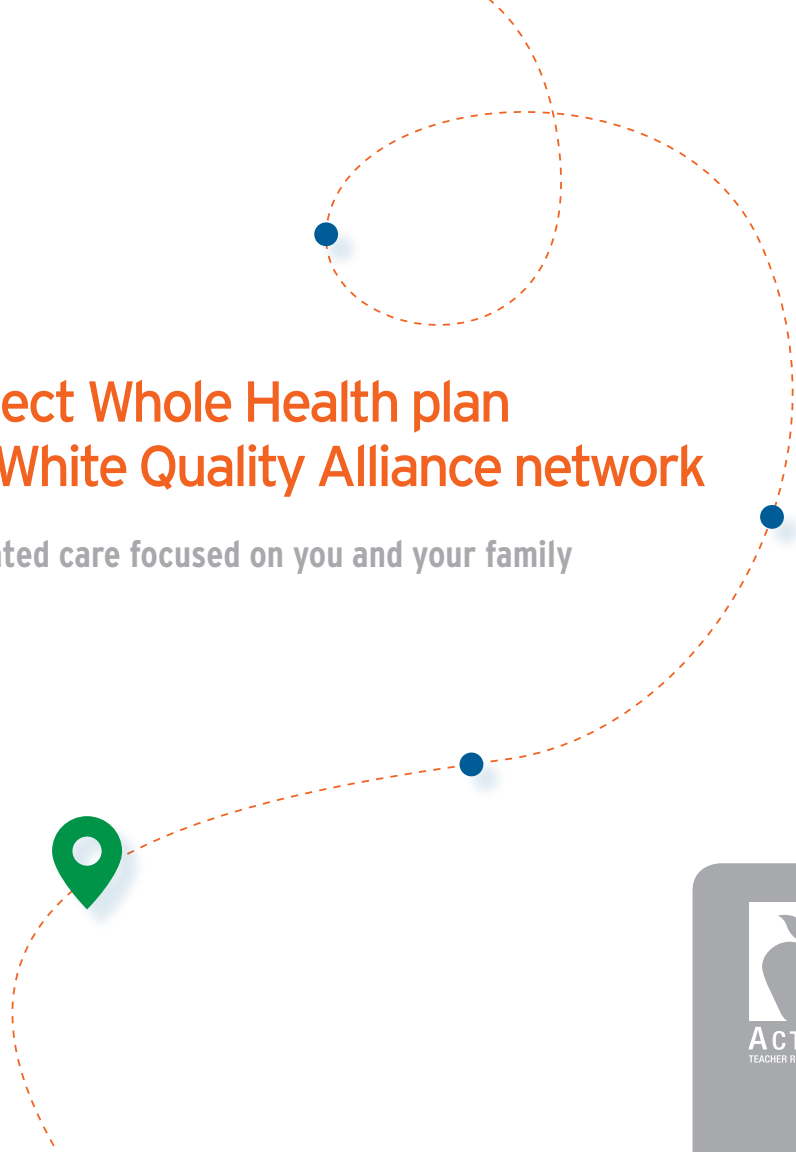

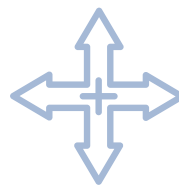

The TRS-ActiveCare Select Whole Health Baylor Scott & White Quality Alliance network plan is expanding into your area for the 2018-19 plan year. Your current plan network, the TRS-ActiveCare Select nationwide network, will no longer be available. With the Baylor Scott & White Quality Alliance network plan, you will have access to a focused, local network and all the advantages of an Accountable Care Organization (ACO) plan.



Bell County Residents:

You have the option to choose either TRS-ActiveCare Select Whole Health local network plan — Baylor Scott & White Quality Alliance or Seton Health Alliance — or the TRS-ActiveCare 1-HD nationwide network plan during annual enrollment.

If you don't take action, you will be covered under the plan (Baylor Scott & White Quality Alliance or Seton Health Alliance) whose providers you have previously visited. If you have not visited providers in either plan network, you will be covered under the plan closest to your home address.

WHAT IF YOUR DOCTORS AND SPECIALISTS ALL KNEW EACH OTHER AND COLLABORATED ON YOUR MEDICAL CARE?

This is the approach taken by the TRS-ActiveCare Select Whole Health plan. As a participant, you'll have access to the Baylor Scott & White Quality Alliance network — primary care doctors, specialists, nurses and hospitals dedicated to keeping you healthy and providing the right care when you need it.

You'll have a care team led by your network primary care doctor. All of your team members will know your history, current medications and plan for care. This means you'll avoid duplicate tests, dangerous drug interactions and conflicting courses of treatment. When your health care is coordinated, you will have a better experience and pay less overall for your care.

WHAT DOES THIS CHANGE MEAN FOR YOU?

Your current plan network, the TRS-ActiveCare Select nationwide network, will no longer be available. If you take no action prior to **August 10, 2018**, you will be automatically placed in the TRS-ActiveCare Select Whole Health Baylor Scott & White Quality Alliance local network plan for 2018-19. **If you do not want this plan for 2018-19, you must make an active enrollment decision by August 24, 2018, to either elect the TRS-ActiveCare 1-HD plan or opt out of coverage entirely.**

THE BAYLOR SCOTT & WHITE QUALITY ALLIANCE NETWORK INCLUDES:

- The largest hospital system in the state of Texas and a network of more than 1,000 primary care doctors and 3,000 specialists
- 58 hospitals, including seven hospitals named by U.S. News & World Report as 2017-18 best hospitals in Texas
- 42 urgent care centers
- More than a dozen convenient MinuteClinics® inside CVS or Target stores, and Healthcare Clinics inside Walgreens with extended hours
- An established team of RN care managers, health coordinators and social workers coordinating care for patients



It's important to remember that TRS-ActiveCare Select Whole Health only covers **care from in-network providers**. If it's a true medical emergency, the plan will cover care from an out-of-network provider.

If you have dependents who do not live with you and must receive **care from providers outside** of the Baylor Scott & White Quality Alliance network, you may want to consider enrolling in the TRS-ActiveCare 1-HD plan. The TRS-ActiveCare 1-HD plan has a nationwide network and covers out-of-network care.
